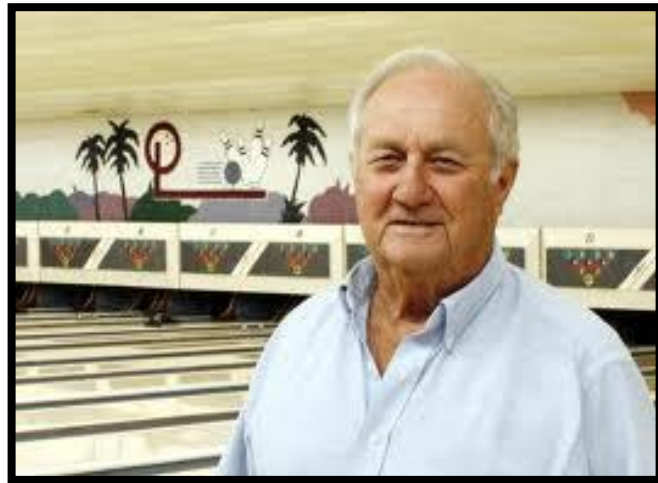

Native-Floridian Bob Dykes moved to Brandon from Miami in 1962 and started as an architect in the firm Dykes Johnson Architects. In the 1980s he and two partners built Oakfield Lanes.

Bob served on the Bowling Centers Association of Florida (BCAF) in every capacity from director to President. He tirelessly worked to promote the sport of bowling, especially youth bowling.

Besides serving the bowling industry, he also served the Brandon community as a former president of the Brandon Rotary Club, Greater Brandon Chamber of Commerce and North Brandon Little League. He was worshipful master of the Brandon Masonic Lodge 114 and chairman of the planning commission of Hillsborough County and of the construction licensing board of Hillsborough County.

BCAF's Bob Dykes Memorial Scholarship was launched in 2013, two years after Dykes' death.

This Scholarship is awarded annually to one High School Senior USBC Youth member who bowls in a BCAF member center.

The Bob Dykes Memorial Scholarship annually recognizes a USBC Youth bowler for their community involvement and academic achievements. One winner will be chosen and awarded a \$1,000 scholarship.

The Bowling Centers Association of Florida presents this prestigious scholarship in honor of the late Bob Dykes. Bob was dedicated to helping youth bowlers and the BCAF is proud to continue these efforts in his name.

Eligibility and Requirements – Must include all listed below, otherwise application will be denied!

1. Be entering their senior year of high school for the year of 2017/18.
2. Be a current USBC Youth member
3. Must bowl at a Bowling Centers Association of Florida (BCAF) member center (*look on bcaf.us under member centers*) and reside in the State of Florida.
4. Have a current GPA of 3.0 or better, based on a 4.0 scale
5. Completed application – **Essay must be typed**
6. Include a headshot photo on disk or travel stick
7. Include at least one (1) letter of reference (by a teacher, principal, employer, etc.)
8. Return all completed documentation and application to BCAF post-marked no later than August 18, 2017. (**Partial or incomplete applications will not be accepted**)
